



MAYOR OF PODGORICA-Dr Miomir Mugoša

Dr Miomir Mugoša was born July 23rd 1950 in Cetinje. He attended elementary school and Gymnasium in Podgorica, and he graduated at the University of Medicine in Belgrade.

Miomir Mugoša worked in the Ambulance Service of Health Institution and later in the Surgery Clinic of Clinical Centre of Montenegro. He performed a duty of Clinical Centre director in the period of 1996 – 1997.

Mayor Mugoša was a Minister with the longest mandate in the Government of Montenegro. From 1990 till November 2000 he was a Minister of Health, with the exception of three months when he performed a Minister of Work and Social Care. In July 2000 he was elected a Mayor of Podgorica Municipality, and after irregular local elections in November 2002 he was once more elected for the same position. In September 2006 in direct elections he was elected a Mayor of Capital Podgorica.

At the position of the Mayor of Podgorica, he was again elected July 19th 2011 by the City Parliament.

Mayor Mugoša is a member of Democratic Socialist Party from its founding.

He lives in Podgorica, at Mareza, in a family house, at the property of his ancestors.

He speaks Russian and basic English. He likes sports, specially football, basketball and tennis. He has two sons Miljan and Marko.
